GENERAL INFORMATION

PROTYX AERIAL is an activator adjuvant specifically formulated to enhance the performance of a wide range of fungicides, and their tank mixes, when applied by aerial application equipment. PROTYX AERIAL combines the proven fungicide activation technology of PROTYX with phytobland oils and phosphate esters to buffer the spray solution, improve compatibility and enhance deposition of fungicides and insecticides into the target crop canopy. *Use PROTYX AERIAL when a phytobland crop oil is required.*

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE WITH PESTICIDES REGISTERED FOR AGRICULTURAL, FORESTRY, NONCROPLAND AND OTHER APPROPRIATE USES.

USE RATES

- AERIAL application: Apply PROTYX AERIAL at ½ pint in 2-3 gallons of water per acre.
Apply PROTYX AERIAL at 1 pint in 4-5 gallons of water per acre.
- Ground application: PROTYX AERIAL is not recommended. Instead, use PROTYX at 1 pint per 100 gallons of spray solution. See Protymax label for details.

MIXING

Always mix this product in accordance with the instructions found on the pesticide label concerning adjuvants. In the absence of specific mixing instructions, fill the spray tank 3/4 full of desired water volume. While the water is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order: 1. If foaming is anticipated, use an antifoam/defoamer. 2. Add PROTYX AERIAL to the spray solution and continue agitation. 3. Water-soluble packets (WSPs), dry flowables and dispersible granule pesticides. 4. Make sure WSPs are completely dissolved before adding micronutrients. 5. Flowable pesticides. 6. Water-soluble pesticides. 7. Emulsifiable concentrate pesticides. 8. Continue agitation and finish filling spray tank to desired level.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not use, spill or store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed tightly when not in use. Prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container. Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of container in a safe manner in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.
